#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello NYSSMA members,

For most of us it was a mild (but cold) winter and spring is almost upon us. With winter came Flu, Covid resurgence and RSV. It was hard to stay healthy with all the viruses floating around and a lot of us contracted one or more of the three. This is where the push for vaccination comes in. I was leery of the Covid vaccine at first, so I understand. Since I have no immune system after my transplant, my doctors urged me to get vaccinated. I had to get three full vaccinated before I got any boosters. I have since had boosters every 6 months and am



happy to say I have not gotten Covid despite being at a conference in Myrtle Beach with people who had it and didn't know until after. I even got antibodies! So please if you have not gotten vaccinated or boosted, I urge you to reconsider.

Two resolutions were sent to the MSSNY House of Delegates in April 2023. They have become proposed legislation in need of your support. Please see below for a brief recap of these compelling resolutions that were submitted by the 8th District, which have now been introduced as proposed bills in both the Assembly and the Senate!

Brief Recap of the 8th District Resolutions That Are Now Pending Legislation:

1. Limited Expansion of Scope of Work for Credentialed Medical Assistants to Perform Vaccinations:

At the House, our physicians testified how it has become unsustainable for practices to remain open and be able to afford to continue to perform vaccinations. As such, our 8th District Delegates and physicians throughout the State plead for NYS to replicate measures already enacted in other jurisdictions throughout the country where Certified Medical Assistants are authorized to issue vaccines. After hearing all testimony, we are pleased to report that the House voted to refer this resolution, which means that this resolution will be further discussed at a MSSNY Committee to discern whether to adopt this measure. We will be sure to update you all with the outcome of this resolution once decided.

#### 2. Funding Primary Care:

At the House, physicians throughout the State testified that other States, like Rhode Island and Connecticut, have required that the regional payors fund primary care. This approach in those States has resulted in a savings in healthcare in the amount of some \$115 million and has made the practice of primary care sustainable. This resolution was characterized as an effort to fund "preventive" medicine, as an investment in primary care would thus allow physicians to take a proactive approach to medicine and prevent the development of comorbidities on the front-end. We are pleased to report that our Physician Delegates and Delegates throughout the state submitted powerful testimony, and as a result, the House voted to adopt this Resolution!

### PLEASE USE YOUR COLLECTIVE VOICES TO ADVANCE THIS LEGISLATION!

With spring just around the corner so is the 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual NYSSMA Convention. Our Convention Committee has been hard at work making sure we have plenty of great CEUs.
